The announcement came in Stewart at the end of the 2011 Minerals North Conference where over 250 delegates from the industry met with Northern businesses in a two day tradeshow and network conference. The conference will be exceptionally timed with the Northwest Transmission Line nearing completion and many mining projects gearing up in the area.
