COUNCIL LOOKS FOR YOUTH TO SERVE ON THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

City Council is assembling a Youth Advisory Committee to advise Council on issues of concern to youth in the Terrace area. The Committee will consist of the Mayor, one City Employee and 15 Youth between the ages of 13 to 19 years old. The establishment of the Youth Advisory Committee was one of the Council initiatives identified at a strategic planning session held earlier this year.

The Youth Advisory Committee will be a youth-led Committee which will share their insights and opinions with Terrace Council on a range of issues. As well as advising Council, the Committee may take on specific projects. "The Youth Advisory Committee will provide an opportunity for local youth to be heard on issues that matter to them. Council would like to ensure that Terrace is a youth-friendly and inclusive community." says Mayor David Pernarowski.

The City is seeking youth in the Terrace area to apply to be appointed to this volunteer Committee. Appointments to the Committee would be for a one-year term beginning in September and ending the following August. Those interested in the Youth Advisory Committee are asked to contact the City of Terrace for further details. The deadline to submit applications for the 2009 – 2010 school year is August 28, 2009.
