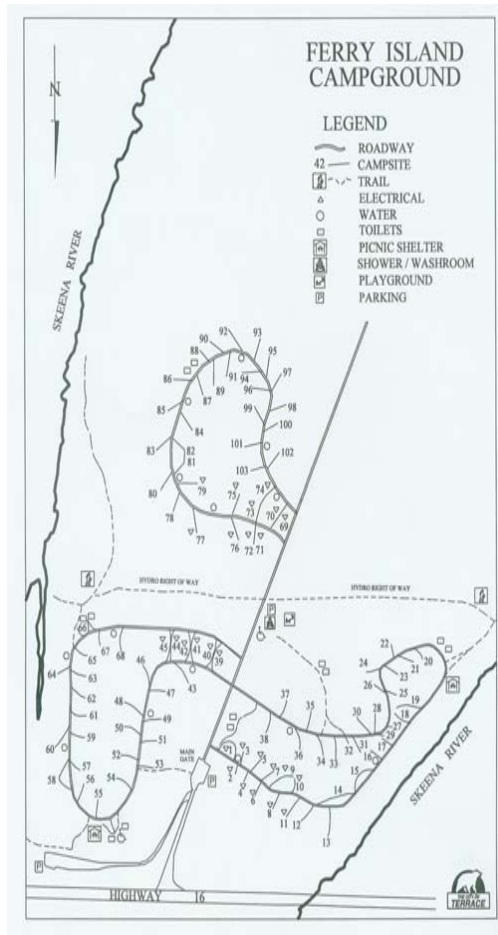


# Tourist Attractions

## *General Park Information*

*This 150 acre park is situated 3.5 km from downtown Terrace on highway 16.*

*It boasts 103 campsites serviced with picnic tables, fire grates, municipal water and outhouses.*

*Community showers are on location. Campsites with electricity are available as well.*

*The campground is open from May until the end of September.*

*There is a caretaker on duty overnight.*

*There are two picnic shelters for use during inclement weather.*

## *Ferry Island Campground*

### *Hours of Operation*

*Campground gate opens at 7am and close at 11pm*

*Only registered campers are permitted in the campground and park area after 11pm*

### *Check In / Check Out Procedures*

*Check in time for first-come, first- served campsites is between 7am and 11pm*

### *Reservations*

*Reservation will only be accepted with cash or credit card payment in advance. NO REFUNDS will be issued for cancellation*

### *Fee Collection*

*The park facility operator will collect the camping fee at your campsite. During busy times you may be required to check in at the office to pay for your campsite. Payment is cash only. You must display your registration receipt on the campsite number post.*

### *Camping Party Definition*

*Camping fees apply per unit basis. Extra fees will be applied on additional vehicles.*

### *Quiet Hours*

*Quiet hours are between 11pm and 7am. Generators, stereos etc must be shut off during this time.*

### *Pets*

*Pets must be leashed in the campground and playground areas.*

### *Firewood*

*Firewood is for sale at the park facility operator's office.*

## *Visitor Information*

***There is a 2.8 km hiking trail around the perimeter of the island which branches into shorter trails. This is a fun walk for children of all ages. Ask about the 'leash free' zones for your dogs. Look for unique carvings along the trail, carved for your enjoyment by a local artist.***

***Fisherman's Park boat launch is located 10 minutes west of Ferry Island along Highway 16.***

***A sani dump is available 1 km west of the island at the Terrace Info Centre on Highway 16.***

***Laundry facilities are situated downtown Terrace.***

***Showers on site.***

***Children's playground.***
