

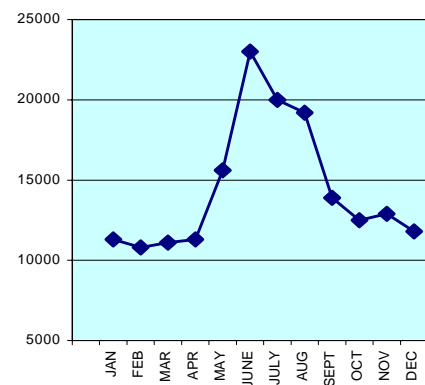
Water Conservation Program - Guide Booklet

It's packed with information on the wise use of water for both inside and outside the home. The guide shows you how to test for and repair leaks, make the most efficient use of water when doing daily chores, and plan landscapes with water efficiency in mind. Although water around Terrace is plentiful, the treatment and delivery of safe water to our residents is not free. The cost of running the water system in the City of Terrace is over one million dollars each year. If we use water carefully we may not have to look for additional water supplies or upgrade our pipe systems for many years.

The biggest single strain on our system is lawn sprinkling. Hot summer weather will more than double water use in Terrace and often puts us on the edge of not having enough water reserves for fire fighting. The water efficiency guide tells you how to keep water use down while still maintaining a healthy lawn.
