The site was launched several months ago to assist with recruitment issues regarding major projects in the area. iChinook.ca is an initiative of the Northwest Labour Market Partnership (NLMP) to bring together stakeholder groups to promote the growth of skilled labour in Northwest BC. iChinook.ca was designed to increase employment of local community members, including aboriginal populations, bv providing resources for education, training, and employment opportunities, as well as to reduce potential skill and labour shortages and strengthen supply for local businesses and industry. The site features information about Northwest BC, changing workforce demands, in-demand jobs, training and funding opportunities, and social media connections.
