- (c) I have resided in British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before today;
- (d) I have been a registered owner of the real property described above, for at least 30 days immediately before today;
- (e) I am not entitled to register as a resident elector in the **City of Terrace** in which the property is situated;
- (f) I am not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust;
- (g) I am not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election, or otherwise disqualified from voting;
- (h) I am the person named in the written consent attached as the person entitled to vote for the property described above (this only applies if there is more than one registered owner of the property).

The <i>Local Government Act</i> requires applicants registering as non-resident electors at the time of voting to produce two documents as evidence of their identity, at least one of which must include the applicant's signature.	<b>Identification 1</b>
