# CAMPFIRE BAN HAS BEEN LIFTED FOR THE CITY OF TERRACE AND FERRY ISLAND

TERRACE – The current campfire ban in the City of Terrace has been lifted, allowing small backyard fires in city limits and campfires on Ferry Island.

All other fires remain prohibited, and all fires are still prohibited outside of City limits.

This decision was made by the Terrace Fire Department in light of wet weather that is forecasted for the coming week.
