### **CAMPFIRE BAN HAS BEEN LIFTED FOR THE CITY OF TERRACE AND FERRY ISLAND**

*TERRACE – The current campfire ban in the City of Terrace has been lifted, allowing small backyard fires in city limits and campfires on Ferry Island.*

*All other fires remain prohibited, and all fires are still prohibited outside of City limits.*

*This decision was made by the Terrace Fire Department in light of wet weather that is forecasted for the coming week.*
