These polices include:

- All facility patrons must have a reservation within a scheduled swim block to enter and use the facility:
- All facility patrons will pay drop in admission rates, which means there will be no discounted admissions, free use admission, or memberships;
- For the purpose of drop in admission the definition of a family will be up to 4 persons maximum; and
- Child admission rate will be applied to babies and toddlers 0-2 years of age.
