**DELEGATIONS & GUESTS:** 

Gordon Stamp-Vincent, Terrace & District Chamber of Commerce – Property Tax Taskforce Gordon Stamp-Vincent, Vice President of the Terrace & District Chamber of Commerce, introduced himself and passed out 3 documents to Mayor and Council that contained information pertaining to his report.

Gordon Stamp-Vincent, Vice-President of the Terrace & District Chamber of Commerce (the Chamber) distributed a number of documents to Council, including a comparison of 2012 Tax Rates in selected communities in Northern BC and a comparison of tax class proportions and assessments in various communities. At the City's January 21, 2013 public meeting to discuss the 2013-2017 provisional budget, the City asked if business taxes should be lowered, and residential Regular Council Meeting, February 12, 2013

taxes increased. The Chamber is concerned that the tax multiple for the business tax class is too high and this results in less economic prosperity for the community. Mr. Stamp-Vincent argued that due to the greater tax burden new businesses will not locate in Terrace and the community will not be competitive.

Mr. Stamp-Vincent introduced Maatje Stamp-Vincent as another guest to speak to the presentation. Ms. Stamp-Vincent asked Council who should bear the burden of providing revenues to local governments. She pointed out that property assessments for residents have been increasing in value but commercial property assessments have remained relatively unchanged. When there is a property tax increase, there is a greater impact on businesses as they pay a higher tax rate than residents.

Mr. Stamp-Vincent concluded the presentation and recommended that the City of Terrace Mayor and Council strike a taskforce of six to eight residential and non-residential taxpaying representatives to examine this issue in depth and report back at a Regular Council meeting by the Fall of 2013 to provide information for the 2014 budget discussion.

Deputy Mayor Bidgood thanked Mr. & Ms. Stamp-Vincent for their presentation, and advised that this matter would be further dealt with under the "Correspondence" portion of this meeting's Agenda (see Resolution No. 062).
