Mr. Clarke stated the celebrations are planned to begin with relay orientation at 10:30 a.m., followed by the torch relay taking place between 2-4:30 p.m. Speakers will take the stage from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. with the fireworks scheduled at 8 p.m. It's estimated up to 2,000 people may attend this event.
