# 1. HOUSING COMMITTEE - FINAL HOUSING ACTION

It was recommended that a review and update for the Housing Needs Assessment be undertaken within the next two years and that the Director of Development Services provide the anticipated costs for the review and update of the Housing Needs Assessment for Council's consideration during the 2013 budget process.

It was also recommended that the City continue to lobby the Provincial and Federal Governments for housing supports.

It was also recommended that the City support the project development and potential construction of the Tuck Avenue Seniors' Housing project; that a Housing Project Steering Committee be established to pursue development of additional subsidized housing units for seniors at Tuck Avenue and that the Steering Committee explore the transition to a non-profit Terrace Housing Society following the completion (if successful) of the Tuck Avenue Seniors Housing project; and that funding and expertise be sought from Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation to co-host a one-day housing workshop in 2013 with the focus of establishing a non-profit housing society in Terrace.

It was also recommended that the undeveloped Cityowned properties at Haugland Avenue, Park Avenue and Olson Avenue be considered for affordable housing sites and that the City target these properties for partnership when funding opportunities area available from the Federal and Provincial governments.

It was also recommended that the City acquire additional lands, as the opportunity and resources may allow, for future affordable community housing development.
