### *BYLAW NO.* − 2022

# "A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF TERRACE TO AMEND BUSINESS LICENCE BYLAW NO. 2112-2016, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO."

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the City of Terrace has adopted Business Licence Bylaw No. 2112-2016, and amendments thereto;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Municipal Council of the City of Terrace, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1.0 Schedule "A," Part I of Business Licence Bylaw No. 2112-2016 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
