



Province of BC Provides Funding for Infrastructure Upgrades for Environmental Protection

City of Terrace to receive \$5m from Critical Community Infrastructure Fund

The City of Terrace is set to receive \$5 million from the Province of BC, via the Critical Community Infrastructure Fund. This funding will be used to assist the City of Terrace in meeting compliance standards and remediation work at the closed Terrace Landfill site.

Funds will be used for treatment upgrades to manage leachate, solid waste and gases. This will lessen the risk of contaminated water leaking into the environment while reducing greenhouse gases and protecting natural areas for future generations.

"The City of Terrace is excited and welcomes this funding announcement of \$5 million to assist in the remediation work at the recently closed Terrace Landfill. This work has been identified by our staff as a key priority and this funding allows us to undertake other important infrastructure work/capital improvements."- Mayor Bujtas
