



McConnell Slide Remediation Works Completed

*Update to January 24, 2023 Media Release*

The remediation of the McConnell Slide is now complete, with ongoing work for demobilization and environmental monitoring still taking place. This work was completed by Progressive Ventures Construction, Bear Creek Construction and McElhanney:

- Progressive Ventures Construction- contracted for the mitigation work.
- Bear Creek Construction- contracted for the rock source, with some being sourced from the Kitsumkalum Quarry.
- McElhanney- contracted for the engineering, surveying, and environmental aspects of the work during and post construction.

Funding for this project was provided by the Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness (EMCR) to undertake mitigation work to protect city infrastructure as well as for monitoring throughout construction and three months post construction phase.

Throughout this project, contractors have been in contact with , Ministry of Environment, Department of Fisheries and Ocean and Kitsumkalum First Nation to address instream river erosion, fish habitat and other environmental concerns.
