

## MCCONNELL CRESCENT LANDSLIDE RECOVERY RESPONSE

Emergency Management British Columbia approved funding under the Emergency Program Act

On September 12, 2022, Emergency Management British Columbia (EMBC) approved funding of \$2,438,756.00 under the *Emergency Program Act* to mitigate the ongoing landslide hazard occurring on the Kitsumkalum River escarpment near McConnell Crescent, within the City of Terrace. This funding has been approved to protect municipal infrastructure from further failures related to river erosion.

The City of Terrace is working with engineering consultants to develop permitting, final engineering drawings and cost estimates to implement the remediation strategy for river erosion protection and slope armouring.
