

How tall can I build a fence?


On residential properties, fences can be a maximum height of 1.2 m (4') in the front yard and 1.85 m (6') in the side and rear yards.



If the front parcel line is adjacent to an arterial roadway, the maximum front yard fence height may be increased to 1.85 m (6').

How is fence height measured?

Fence height is the vertical distance between the ground level and the top of the fence **at any given point**.




What materials can I use to screen my property?

Fences, compact evergreen hedges, landscaping, or a combination may be used to screen properties from adjacent parcels or highways.

Barbed wire and electrical fences are not permitted on most properties in the City of Terrace and are **not permitted on any residential properties** in the City of Terrace.

Are there any restrictions on where I can locate my fence or screening?

On intersecting parcel lines at street, lane, roadway, or driveway corners, any screening including fences, berms, trees, or bushes is not permitted to be over 1 m (3') tall in the area described below. This is to ensure sightlines are maintained.
