APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT

TAKE NOTICE THAT an application has been made for a Development Variance Permit.

TAKE NOTICE ALSO THAT the application affects the property and land within the City of Terrace at **4423 Eby Street** shown hatched and in bold outline on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

To vary Section 6.1 of Sign Bylaw No. 2102-2016 and amendments thereto to allow one Freestanding Sign on the property with a maximum area of 2.4 square meters, a maximum height of 2.4 meters, and a minimum required setback of 7.0 meters from a lot line.

The subject property is zoned AR2 - Rural. This permit is being considered to allow a freestanding sign on the property.

The proposed **Development Variance Permit may be inspected** in the reception area at the City of Terrace PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING at 5003 Graham Avenue, Terrace, B.C. between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., each day, from Friday, November 15, 2024 to Monday, November 25, 2024 excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays.
