



**CITY OF TERRACE**  
**ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION**

**Public Notice is hereby given that advance registration for the 2022 General Local Election closes on August 23, 2022.**

**Are you eligible to vote in the 2022 General Local Election elections for the positions of Mayor and Councillors?**

**Is your name on the current list of electors?**

If you are not sure you can find out by calling or visiting Terrace City Hall (3215 Eby Street). The office is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday (excluding holidays).

Advance elector registrations will be accepted at the City of Terrace City Hall until August 23, 2022. Elector registrations will not be accepted during the period of August 24 to October 17, 2022 but will be accepted on voting days.

**ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS**

**RESIDENT ELECTORS:**

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election or assent voting; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a resident of the City of Terrace; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

**NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:**

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election or assent voting; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a registered owner of real property in the [municipality or electoral area] for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law; and
- **if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.**
