Nomination forms are available at Terrace City Hall or at www.terrace.ca from Tuesday, March 23, 2021 to the close of the nomination period.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day June 5, 2021;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2021 local by-election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Beginning April 20, 2021 until the close of general voting for the election on June 5, 2021, a copy of the list of registered electors will be available for public inspection, at the City of Terrace office at 3215 Eby Street, during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not inspect the list or use the information included in the list except for the purposes of Part 3 – Electors and Elections of the *Local Government Act*. An elector may request that their address or other information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors.

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4:00 pm on April 30, 2021. An objection must be in writing and may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the City of Terrace and can only be made on the basis that a person whose name appears on the list of electors has died or that a person whose name appears on the list of electors is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the City of Terrace.
