Garbage is collected bi-weekly, shown in grey. Recycling is collected bi-weekly, shown in blue. Organic material is collected weekly, shown in green. Yard waste is collected only on Mondays from April to November, shown in yellow.

Curbside Collection Guidelines

ALL MATERIALS: GARBAGE, RECYCLING & ORGANICS

TO THE CURB BEFORE 8:00 am

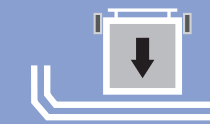


All materials must be at the curbside by 8:00 am on the designated collection day.

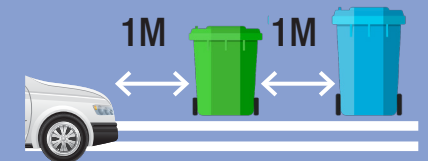
Please note that carts/bags containing unacceptable materials will not be collected.

COLLECTION DAY CART PLACEMENT



Point It
Arrows should point to the centre of the road.



Space it
1m clearance all around the cart

Carts must be at curbside, within 1 metre (3 feet) of the travelled portion of the road. Position cart with arrows pointing to centre of road with at least 1 metre clearance around the cart as shown.



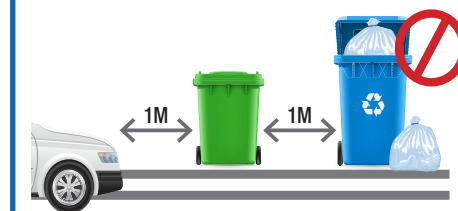

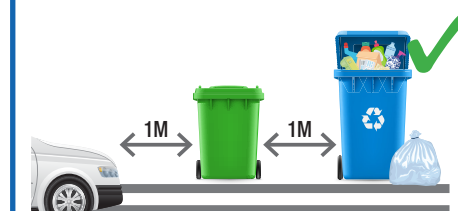
Garbage Collection

- Curbside garbage is collected **alternating weeks** with recycling collection.
- Garbage is limited to one 240 litre cart per household every second week.
- If necessary for extra refuse, "Garbage Tags" are available for \$2.00 each at any City office. The maximum weight of additional tagged refuse is 22kgs (50lbs) per **bag**.
- Cat litter, animal excrement, sawdust, cold ashes, broken glass, and wet refuse must be thoroughly drained, and wrapped in paper or plastic before being placed in the cart.

Recycling Collection

- Curbside recycling is collected **alternating weeks** with garbage collection. Please visit www.terrace.ca or www.recyclebc.ca for a detailed list of acceptable materials at the curbside and at the depot.
- There is no limit to recycling placed at curbside, but collection is restricted to recycling materials from the residence.
- Recycling materials should be placed **loosely / directly** in the cart. Additional materials shall be placed in transparent (clear) plastic bags beside the cart.
- For cardboard too large for recycling container, flatten and tie in bundles no larger than 8" thick x 30" wide x 30" tall and place beside recycling containers.
- Glass, Styrofoam, plastic bags and overwrap are not accepted in curbside recycling. These items can be taken to the local Recycle BC Depot, "Do Your Part Recycling" located at 3467 Hwy 16 East.





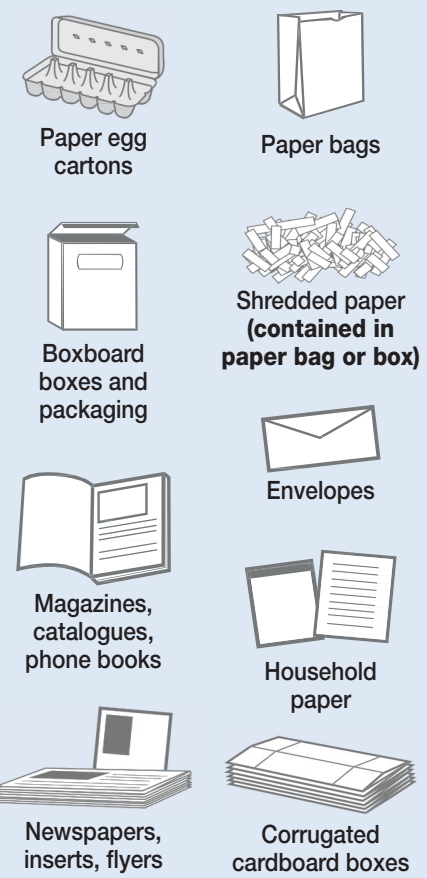
Recycling Collection

- Recycling materials should be placed **loosely/directly** in the cart.
- Only put out acceptable materials for curbside collection.

ACCEPTED MATERIAL

CONTAINERS

PAPER



- ✓ Plastic packaging for toys and other household items
 - ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, coffee, etc.
 - ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.
 - ✓ Plastic pails less than 25L for laundry detergent, etc.
 - ✓ Paper carry-out beverage trays
 - ✓ Cores from paper towel and toilet tissue
 - ✓ Paper bags for flour, sugar, etc.
- REMEMBER:**
- ✓ Empty and rinse containers, labels OK
 - ✓ Remove caps, pumps and lids, place loose in container box
 - ✓ Put metal lids inside cans and squeeze tightly

- ### NOT ACCEPTED
- Do **NOT** place in curbside recycling
- Glass
 - Plastic bags and overwrap
 - Foam packaging
 - Paper towels, napkins and tissues
 - Hard and soft cover books
 - Electronics and appliances
 - Hazardous waste (needles, flammable/explosive/toxic material etc.)
 - Hangers, pots, pans, and other scrap metal
 - Toys and games

- ✓ Bags for groceries, produce, bulk dry foods, water softener, wood pallets, etc.
 - ✓ Overwrap for toilet paper, paper towel, soft drink flats, etc.
 - ✓ Light bulbs (*No light fixtures*)
 - ✓ Foil lined bags (*chip & snack bags*)
 - ✓ Kitchen stretch wrap or "crinkly" plastic (pasta or cereal bags)
 - ✓ Paints, solvents, gasoline, flammable liquids & pesticides (*Must have original label*)
- ✗ Drinking glasses or dishes
 - ✗ Window glass, mirrors or ceramic
 - ✗ Light fixtures
 - ✗ Flexible foam or foam noodles
 - ✗ Blue or pink foam insulation, packing chips, or peanuts



Organics Collection

- Curbside organics is collected on a weekly basis on the same day as garbage or recycling collection.
- Organics is limited to one 120 litre cart per household every week.
- If you only have a small amount of organics please help our crews work efficiently and consider setting your green organics cart out on GARBAGE weeks only.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS



- ✓ Fruits and vegetables
- ✓ Meat, poultry, fish, and seafood (bones & shells)
- ✓ Fish and seafood
- ✓ Eggs, Egg shells and dairy
- ✓ Noodles, rice, beans, grains, and bread
- ✓ Tea bags and coffee grounds
- ✓ Food soiled paper (napkins, paper plates, paper take-out containers, pizza boxes etc.)
- ✓ Newspaper (for wrapping food scraps or lining kitchen containers)
- ✓ Parchment and wax paper
- ✓ Grass clippings and leaves
- ✓ Weeds, plants, and flowers (no noxious plants)
- ✓ Short branches and prunings (less than 75mm (3 inches) in diameter and 50cm (20 inches) in length)

Approved bags must display one of the following logos:



- ### NOT ACCEPTED
- Do **NOT** place in organics collection
- Plastic
 - Diapers or fecal matter
 - Animal waste
 - Glass
 - Branches or prunings over 75 mm thick and 50 cm long
 - Lumber or other wood products
 - Rocks, soil, or sod
 - Biodegradable plastic bags
 - Plastic bags, wrap, or containers

Yard Waste Collection



- Additional curbside yard waste will be collected on Mondays from April to early November.
- Yard waste is composted at the City works yard and is used in City parks and boulevard projects.
- Yard waste must be **only** set out in kraft (brown) paper bags for collection.
- There is no bag limit on yard waste collection, but maximum weight per bag should not exceed 22kgs (50lbs).
- Small branches less than 12 mm (1/2 inch) in diameter and less than 1 metre (3 feet) in length are acceptable.
- Cooked food, oil, meat, fish, bones, animal waste and household refuse are **not** accepted in curbside yard waste collection.
