- MLA and MP support





## Taking action

- Several key steps we've taken:
  - Increase downtown police/security presence
  - Support housing initiatives
  - Create Situation Table
  - Hire Social Development Coordinator
  - Complete additional small but vital projects



## Increase downtown police/security

#### presence

Strategy	Challenges
Hired more RCMP officers	Cost (\$130,000 annually/member)
Increased presence downtown of bylaw compliance officers	Bylaw capacity limits our ability to be proactive (additional officers would be \$90,000 annually/officer)
Tried different strategies for private security	Cost and efficacy
Safe Streets Bylaw (in progress)	Making sure we get it right



## Support housing initiatives 4

- Support housing projects at Council meetings
  - Zoning changes
  - Providing City-owned land
  - Approving development permits
  - etc
- Housing Committee
- Housing Needs Assessment (2020 update)
- Annual homeless count



## Create Terrace Situation Table

- Purpose: meet regularly to assist specific individuals facing challenges
- Members include representatives from:
  - City of Terrace staff
  - Northern Health
  - Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction
  - Ksan House Society
  - TDCSS
  - Salvation Army
  - Kermode Friendship Society
  - BC Housing



### Hire Social Development Coordinator

- New role for the City (hiring in progress)
- Help coordinate social planning and policy development
- Work collaboratively across City departments and with other levels of government, First Nations, community organizations, social agencies, and residents
- Funding from LNG Canada and Northern Development Initiative Trust
- We are really looking forward to filling this position!



## Other smaller but vital projects

- New downtown public washroom (fall 2021)
- Supporting detox centres or other similar amenities
- Grant writer program
