

City of Terrace FireSmart Rebate

Thank you for taking the time to complete the FireSmart Assessment around your home and property and to take action into creating a defensible space from potential wildfires around your home, which is within the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI).

Rebate Program Requirements

Rebates are limited to **50%** of the total labor cost of the eligible activities identified below to a maximum of **\$500** per property.

To be eligible for the FireSmart Rebate, the home owner must:

- Have a FireSmart Assessment of their property, conducted by a qualified Local FireSmart Representative (LFR), that identifies the property in a moderate, high, or extreme category.
- Complete some or all activities that are recommended in the assessment and that are eligible under the FireSmart Program, limited to:
 - Roofing:
 - Remove combustible debris and overhanging branches;
 - Replace roofing w/fire rated roofing (labor cost).
 - Siding/Windows:
 - Remove combustible debris;
 - Create 15 cm ground-to-siding non-combustible clearance;
 - Replace siding w/non-combustible or ignition resistant siding (labor cost);
 - Update/replace windows.
 - Decking:
 - Remove all combustible material from under or adjacent to deck;
 - Relocate firewood piles;
 - Replace old decking, enclose deck.
 - Landscaping:
 - Remove woody debris adjacent to house and yard;
- Once FireSmart activities are completed by the home owner, the LFR will review the work and cost before approving rebates.

- Ensure 1.5-meter horizontal non-combustible surface perimeter along the outer walls of the primary structure;
 - Plant low density of fire-resistant plants;
- Remove flammable plants.
- FireSmart Priority Zone 1:
 - Thin and prune trees;
 - Clean up accumulations of fallen branches/fine woody debris;
 - Remove dry grass and needles;
 - Plant deciduous trees.
- FireSmart Priority Zone 2:
 - Plant deciduous trees;
 - Remove standing dead and coarse woody debris; Remove unmaintained grasses;
 - Ensure flammable shrubs are well spaced;
 - Remove low tree branches below two meters from the ground.
