Organics

Did you know that between 30-40% of your household waste is made up of organics (kitchen scraps)?

Backyard Composting: There are many design options for your backyard composter. Build your own from recycled wooden pallets or build a wood and wire bin unit. Many types of composters are available for purchase, including the Earth Machine and Digester. For instructions on how to build your own or to find out how to purchase a composter, visit our website www.rdks.bc.ca.

Organics Collection: The next phase planned for the Terrace Area Curbside Collection Service is the addition of organics collection. This service is planned for implementation once the new Compost Facility at the Forceman Ridge Waste Management site is operational. Organics collected by the City of Terrace is anticipated to be managed at this Compost Facility.

What happens when I put my organics in the landfill?

1. Landfilled organic waste, especially rotting food waste, contributes directly to the production of methane gas in landfills. Methane is a greenhouse gas 21 times stronger than CO₂ (vehicle exhaust).
2. The moisture content in some organics contributes to the production of leachate, which requires management and treatment to ensure protection of ground and surface water and the environment.
3. Finished compost is a rich, natural soil amendment that returns valuable nutrients back into the soil promoting the growth of healthy plants. These nutrients are lost if these valuable resources are landfilled instead of composted.
