



GRANT WRITING ASSISTANCE PILOT ANNOUNCES SECOND GROUP OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS

Collaboration between Terrace Community Foundation and City connects four more community non-profits with hundreds of hours of grant writing support

The City of Terrace and Terrace Community Foundation are excited to announce the second successful cohort of applicants to the Grant Writing Support pilot program. Announced in early May, the program provides grant writing support to local non-profit groups to help secure funding for projects that benefit the community. In this round, the Grant Writing Support team selected four applicants to receive these services: Coast Mountain Children's Society, Kalum Community School Society, Terrace Little Theatre Society, and Terrace and District Community Services Society.

"The first round of successful applicants are currently wrapping up their preliminary work with the grant writer and will be working on applications to secure grants for their projects. We look forward to having this second group come in behind them to keep this program rolling," said City of Terrace Mayor Carol Leclerc.

The City of Terrace received funding to contract the services of a professional grant writer for a year through the pilot program, which is being administered with assistance from the Terrace Community Foundation and with financial support from Northern Development Initiative Trust and LNG Canada.

"These non-profit organizations deliver invaluable services in building a better community, but are invariably challenged in accessing funding to bring projects to fruition. Grant writer support removes a major impediment for organizations which typically rely on small numbers of volunteers," said Norm Parry, Chair of the Terrace Community Foundation.

The third intake is set to open in late fall. More details and deadlines will be provided at a later date.
