Boland will assume his duties effective January 1, 2021. He replaces outgoing CAO Heather Avison, who is retiring on November 30, 2020, after 10 years in the role and 28 in total with the City of Terrace. Council will be appointing Deputy CAO Alisa Thompson as Interim CAO until Boland officially takes over the position.

Boland joins the City of Terrace from the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine, where he spent the last year and a half as Project Manager for the Northwest BC Resource Benefits Alliance, while also filling the role of Deputy CAO for the Regional District. Council recognized that his experience here in Terrace, combined with his prior experience as Director of Finance for the District of Mission, made him the ideal candidate. Boland brings 16-plus years of BC local government experience, with the majority of that time spent in leadership and senior management roles.
