

NEWS RELEASE – MONITORING RIVER LEVELS

Terrace, BC

SUMMARY

The City of Terrace Fire Department is currently monitoring river levels in response to flood risk and flooding occurring in other areas of the province. At this time, there is no risk to the City of Terrace and river levels are demonstrating a typical rise for this time of year.

KEY POINTS

- River levels are currently normal for this time of year during spring run-off;
- Snow pack levels are diminishing at a favourable rate;
- Monitoring of water levels will continue throughout the week; and
- Terrace Fire Department is well-prepared if there is a rapid rise in waters bordering the City.
