CITY OF TERRACE PARTNERING TO BRING 2ND ANNUAL BUSINESS WALK

The City of Terrace, together with The Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine, The Terrace and District Chamber of Commerce, The Northwest Regional Airport, The Ministry of Jobs, Tourism, and Skills Training, Kermode Tourism, Community Futures 16/37, Terrace Downtown Improvement Area, and The Terrace Business Resource Centre will be completing the 2nd Annual Terrace and District Business Walk on the morning of May 10th.

The Business Walk will be conducted by volunteer “walkers”, consisting of teams of civic leaders and business support service providers. They will come to businesses throughout Terrace and Thornhill, and ask a few basic questions about doing business in the area. The questions are meant to gauge the current economic status of our community, but also provide individualized attention to businesses that may not feel like they are being heard. The visit is a chance to establish connections and identify issues as a means of helping businesses to remain strong and vibrant in our community.
