SKEENA INDUSTRIAL PARK DEVELOPMENT CONTINUES WITH TAISHENG PROPERTY ROAD CONSTRUCTION

August 16, 2017

TERRACE – Daudet Creek Contracting Ltd. has been awarded the contract to construct the remainder of Jack Talstra Way, by Taisheng International Investment Services (Taisheng). When complete, this road will provide access to the nearly 1200 acres of property owned by Taisheng, the Canadian representative of the Qinhuangdao Economic and Technological Development Zone (QETDZ).

Road construction will begin soon, and is expected to last until the end of June, 2018. The result will be a 2.2 km paved road running through the center of the Skeena Industrial Development Park. By the end of August, nearly 700 acres of Taisheng's property will be cleared in preparation for infrastructure installation such as internal roads, electricity, and water works.

Taisheng is actively marketing the land in China to potential leasers. Investor tours of the park will continue to showcase the potential for industrial development and form relationships with local officials. These tours will be led by Taisheng's Burnaby-based marketing team with assistance from the QETDZ staff based in China.
