



How to Pay Your 2021 Property Taxes



NEW: Home Owner Grant Application Process

CHANGE IN 2021:

Home Owner Grant applications **MUST** be submitted directly to the Province of BC. This is a province-wide change, and residents are no longer able to apply through their municipal office. Program eligibility is unchanged.

The home owner grant reduces the amount of property tax you pay for your principal residence. If eligible, you must claim your grant each year. To avoid a 10% penalty on the outstanding balance, make sure to **claim your grant by the tax due date.**

Applying for the grant before paying your property taxes is recommended but not required.

Due Date

Property taxes are due **July 2, 2021.**

A **penalty of 10%** will be applied to current taxes that remain unpaid after 4:30 pm July 2, 2021.



How to Pay

Pay with online or telephone banking, or in person at your bank:

- ▶ To pay online, register the City of Terrace as the bill payee and use the "Roll Number" as the account number. Allow at least three business days to process to ensure payment is made on time.

- ▶ Tax payment sent by mail must be received at City Hall by the due date.

Pay in person:

- Cash
- Cheque or post-dated cheque
- Debit (please verify your daily limit)

Note: Credit card payments are NOT accepted.
